Political and Governmental Developments:

- Sashakt Panchayat-Netri Abhiyan: A national workshop was held to empower women elected representatives in Panchayati Raj Institutions, aiming to enhance capacity-building across India. (March 3, 2025)
- 2. India's SDG Progress: India lags in achieving SDGs, with 36 states meeting over half of the targets in just 4 out of 15 SDGs, indicating mixed progress. (March 3, 2025)
- 3. **Central Tax Revenue Reduction**: The Indian government is considering a reduction in states' share of central tax revenues, from 41% to 40%, for fiscal 2026-27. (March 3, 2025)
- 4. **US Official Language**: President Donald Trump announced English as the official language of the United States. (March 4, 2025)

- Blue Ghost Lands on Moon: Firefly Aerospace's Blue Ghost spacecraft became the second private vehicle to land on the Moon, continuing NASA-private sector collaborations. (March 6, 2025)
- 3. **Supreme Court Ruling on Disability Rights**: The Supreme Court ruled that the right against disability-based discrimination is a fundamental right, supporting visually impaired candidates in judicial services. (March 6, 2025)
- India Ranks 3rd Globally in Start-Ups: India ranks 3rd globally in startups, driven by government initiatives. The Union Budget allocated ₹20,000 crore for R&D, and India's innovation ranking improved significantly. (March 7, 2025)
